Dear Minister.

URGENT.

Corrupt Conduct - Justices Robert Osborn and Greg Garde.

I refer you to the enclosed open memo dated 3rd February 2014.

For reasons best known to you and your department officers of your department have denied that the component parts of the fraud described in that memo and asserted that those component parts do "*not contain substantive evidence of the corruption*" alleged by me.

The most recent such denial was by letter dated 7th January 2014 from Marissa De Cicco, Executive Director, Strategic Policy and Legislation.

Notably none of these denials come from you directly.

Until recently the component parts of Osborn's fraud appeared to me to be an opaque conglomeration of disparate fraudulent fabrications but spurred by the fact that the denials of your department are in the face of the unequivocal facts I have now managed to ascertain the exceedingly sophisticated scheme of Osborn's fraudulent fabrications. That exercise opened my eyes to a number of aspects not previously realised by me and which are now also set out in the memo.

My open memo unequivocally sets out that scheme and the fraud of Osborn in a manner which an ordinary lay persons will easily understand, identify with and be reviled at.

Further denial and ignore by you and denial and ignore by your department will be and will be seen to be exceedingly serious.

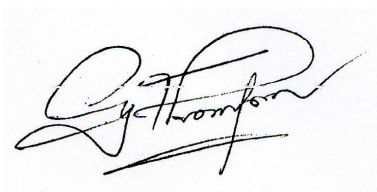
You have a short window of time in which to be seen to act of your own volition to institute inquiry pursuant to the Constitution Act. That widow will close as public awareness grows and you will be seen to have failed to act in a timely manner.

I will be fostering public awareness.

By express post of even date I have forwarded a copy of the memo to the Governor, the Chief Justice, the President of the Court of Appeal, the Premier and to Osborn and Garde. I have also forwarded to other selected recipients.
