Dear Premier.

URGENT.

Corrupt Conduct - Justices Robert Osborn and Greg Garde.

With respect, it is in your interest that you have a senior advisor immediately review the enclosed open memo dated 3rd February 2014.

I have also forwarded copies of the open memo to the Governor, the Chief Justice, the president of the Court of Appeal, the Attorney General, Osborn, Garde and selected recipients.

In the face of the facts, purportedly on behalf of the Attorney General, officers of the Office of the Attorney General have repeatedly denied the component parts of the fraud of Justice Osborn. Most recently by letter dated 7th January 2014.

Spurred by those denials I have now managed to connect the component parts, my open memo now demonstrates the sophisticated scheme of Osborn's fraud which was formulated and conducted in conspiracy with Garde.

I have now set out the scheme of Osborn's fraud in a manner which an ordinary lay persons will clearly understand, identify with and be reviled at. Further denial and ignore will be seen to be exceedingly serious.

As detailed Osborn perpetrated a fraud and then fraudulently fabricated "Authenticated Orders" of the Court in the vain and corrupt hope of concealing that fraud.

I will be distributing my open memo widely.

I respectfully say that if your Attorney General will not act to investigate this matter as provided by the Constitution Act you must appoint an Attorney General who possesses the required courage and integrity.

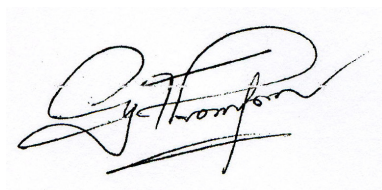
